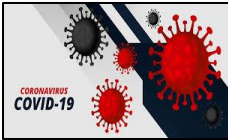

The tour will continue on to Santa Rosa where multiple live farm tours will take place. Tours include visits to livestock ranches, and vegetable and fruit farms. The tour will also take you to Santa Clara (passing through San Francisco) to attend a Food Processing Expo where participants can gain firsthand knowledge on the food processing industry and equipment. The tour will proceed to Bakersfield to visit a live cattle ranch where participants will learn about establishing cattle ranches in Africa. The tour will end in Los Angeles where the farmers will learn about Jatropha-To-Biodiesel opportunities designed for Sub Saharan Africa as well as food processing for the small farmer.

While in Los Angeles participants will have the opportunity to take a tour of Downtown Los Angeles (California largest city) and Hollywood, one of California's largest GDP producers.

5. Environment Remediation for the Oil & Gas Industries

Date: TBD

Event Type: Training

Duration: 160 Days

This 22-week university program covers Environmental Remediation for the Oil & Gas Industries. The training is divided into two phases.

Phase 1 Courses will be delivered in modules with emphases on selected topics to lay the requisite foundation for the practical experience in bioremediation in Phase 2. Homework assignments and tests will form the basis of evaluating Trainees. Courses will run from Monday through Thursday. Students will utilize Fridays and Saturdays to prepare for the upcoming lecture week, complete their assignments and prepare for tests.

Phase 1 consist 13 weeks of comprehensive study and the courses cover the following topics:

Principles of Chemistry I, II
Principles of Organic Chemistry I, II
Principles of Environmental Science
Environmental Microbiology
Aquatic Chemistry
Environmental Toxicology/Ecotoxicology

Principles of Biology I, II
Microbiology
Marine Biology
Earth Science
Environmental Chemistry
Bioremediation

Phase 2 consist of 9 weeks of laboratory and practical training in the field.

The course will have special emphasis on soil and water remediation in wastewater, oilfield, river ways, and the ocean, with limited teaching in the areas of manufacturing, and pharmaceutical.

Course materials and equipment are included. This course is completed at a University of California campus. Students who successfully complete the training will earn a **Certification in Environmental Science.**

This is California's largest furniture event! The Southern California Furniture Accessory Market is for **TRADE ONLY** and is open to individuals that are involved on a professional basis in the furniture, bedding, interior design, and home décor industry. There will be over 700 furniture buyers comprising of retailers and wholesalers as well as designers and over 1,000 attendees.

Participants will have a dedicated area for displaying their furniture sets (furniture must be shipped ahead to arrive on time for the event). GGDG will arrange for any unsold furniture sets to remain here in the U.S. until sold. All proceeds less a small fee, will be forwarded to the Seller upon disposal of the furniture. This will save the costs of shipping back to Africa in case the model is not sold.

In addition, a tour of various furniture manufacturing and retail furniture stores is included. Visiting modern furniture manufacturing facilities will help the Participant to understand which technologies to apply to increase profits. Visiting modern retail furniture establishments will help the Participant to understand what the customer buying

experience should look like and how different customer incentives can help to increase sales.

Participants will have an opportunity to meet potential trade partners, and attend a workshop covering EXIM Bank (U.S. Import Export Bank) financing to purchase equipment for export to countries in Africa.

This event is for businesses and individuals who are in the production of metal and aluminum components who are looking to expand their operations and increase

efficiencies and profits, or those that are seeking to get into the lucrative business of residential and commercial steel framing, metal and aluminum roof sheets.
